Materials List:

- 1 ea. Create-A-House™ - Turp 71
- 1 pkg. Create-A-House™ Miniatures; Large Tools CAH-026, Metal Chair CAH-121, Milk Can CAH-118, Sunflowers CAH-035
- 1 ea. Create-A-House™ Decorative Wood Trim CAH-084
- 2 pkg. Create-A-House™ Wood Trim Corners CAH-101
- 1 ea. Aleene's® Tacky Glue or glue gun and glue sticks
- 1 pc. Sandpaper for Sanding edges to give aged look
- 1 ea. Loew Cornell Comfort Brushes™ Round #3000- size 1, Angular #3400 3/8", Wash #3350 3/4"
- 1 ea. Permanent Black Marker – Fine Tip
- 1 ea. Deer Moss or Moss (Optional)
- 1 ea. DecoArt™ Americana® Acrylic Paint; Terra Cotta DA-062, Raw Umber DA-130, Hauser Dark Green DA-133, Neutral Grey DA-95, Light Buttermilk DA-164, Moon Yellow DA-07

Tips and Tricks:

- **Painting Porch Floorboards:** With brush, load 2-3 colors at one time. Paint board shapes onto porch floor over base color. Pull brush strokes toward you. Keep a thin space between each board.
- **Sanding:** Use a different piece of sand paper for each color. Start by sanding lighter colors first. Wipe off dust with damp cloth.
- **Note:** DO NOT USE hot glue on screen door

Instructions:

1. Paint body of house Terra Cotta DA-062.
2. Paint roof and base of house Raw Umber DA-130.
3. Paint window, door, porch posts, and wood trim Hauser Dark Green DA-133.
4. Use a mixture of Neutral Grey DA-95 and Light Buttermilk DA-164 to paint porch boards over porch floor. (Refer to Tips & Tricks)
5. Paint metal chair using Moon Yellow DA-07.
6. Used black permanent marker to write "MILK" on milk can CAH-118.
7. Glue wood trim under roof over hang. Glue decorative corners to front, sides, and wall of post under porch roof. (Refer to photo)
8. Sand edges of roof, door, windows, and porch posts. (Refer to Tips & Tricks)
9. Glue miniatures to house. (Refer to photo for placement)
